

## Sea Freight LCL Clearances... how does it all work?



You purchase your goods overseas  
Your goods are placed inside  
a container with other goods



The container is placed onboard a ship  
to bring your goods to Australia



If the goods are made from  
wood they need to be fumigated  
prior to shipping

While the goods travel to Australia,  
Platinum Freight<sup>®</sup> will be busy pre-clearing

unpacking and separating.

**SCENARIO 1**

Forestry) release the goods.

DAFF (Department of Agricul-  
ture Fisheries and Forestry)  
wish to inspect the goods
